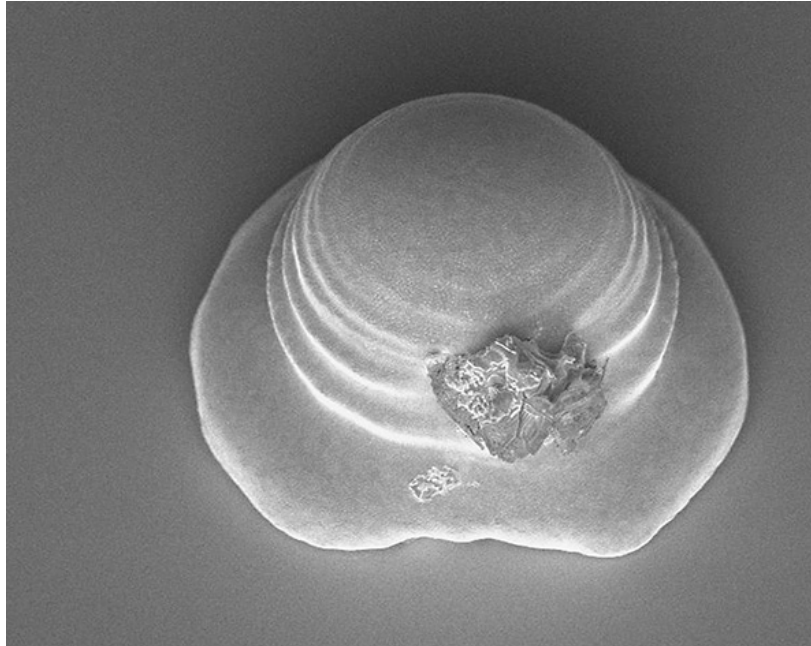

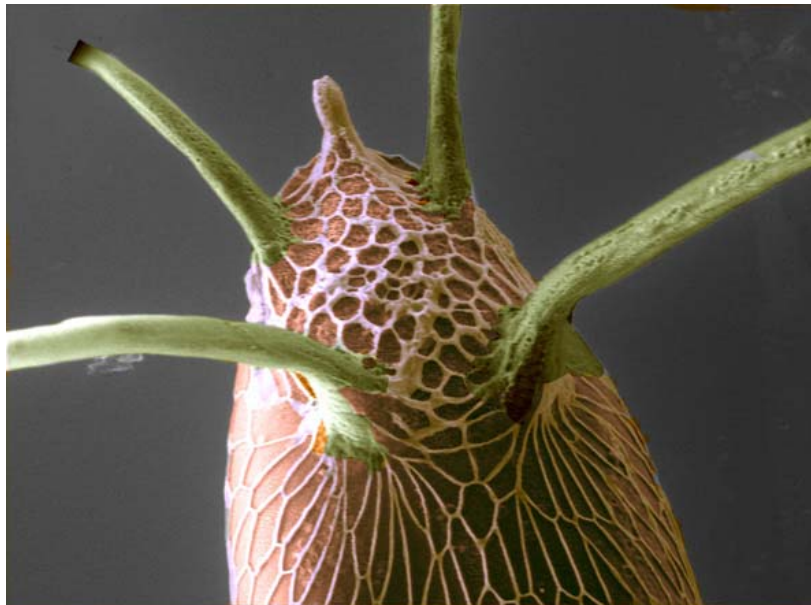


Easter Bonnet
